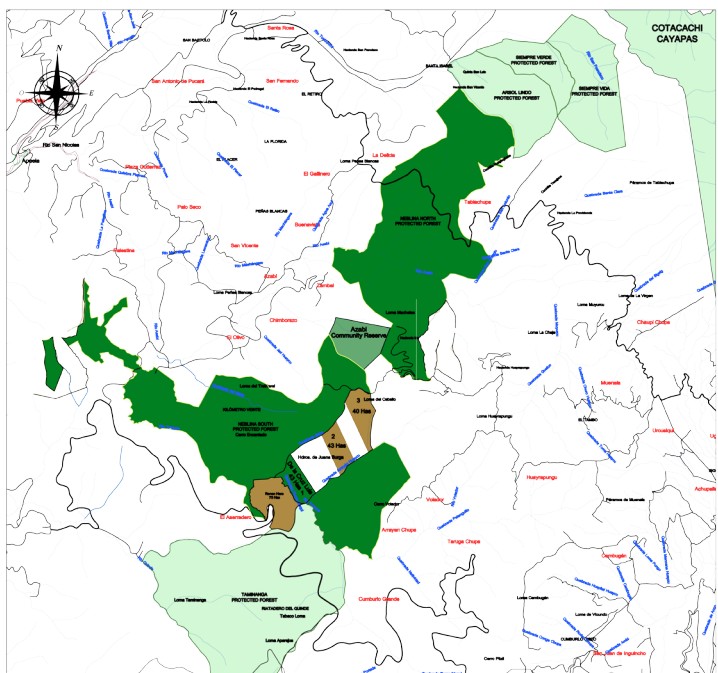

We are so pleased you could join us for Sir Ghilleen Prance's talk this evening.

For the last 20 years Rainforest Concern has been working in the Intag region of north-west Ecuador to help conserve the highly threatened cloud forests.

These unique forests lie in the tropical Andes Global Biodiversity Hotspot, the most diverse hotspot of the 35 in the world. It contains about one-sixth of the Earth's plant life, including 30,000 species of vascular plants, making it the top hotspot for plant diversity. It also has the largest variety of amphibian, bird and mammal species, and takes second place to the Mesoamerica Hotspot for reptile diversity as they are home to many threatened, endemic species.

Sadly, 90% of this incredibly diverse forest has already been lost. To help preserve the precious little that remains, Rainforest Concern set up the Neblina Reserve in 2002 with just 100 hectares. Over the years it has expanded to 2,272 hectares under our management and protection.

Rainforest Concern is committed to continuing to extend the Neblina Reserve to expand the overall biological corridor.

However, we need your help to buy the land, shown in brown on the map, to enable us to create more continuous protected forest which is so vital for the survival of the cloud forest and its array of vulnerable species which rely on it.
